

Summary of Highest Counts of Individuals for the United States

California rebounded to take its traditional first place after foul weather hindered counts last year during the 103rd CBC. The overall United States tally for the 104th count reported 654 species, 37 infraspecific forms, and 31 exotics. All-time highs were recorded for 62 species (bold-faced numerals).

On an individual CBC basis, **Matagorda County-Mad Island Marsh, TX**, led the nation for the third year in a row with the highest counts of 20 species, despite experiencing strong winds all day. Santa Ana, TX, came in second with 16 species, and was followed by Honolulu, HI, with 15 species and two infraspecific forms; Salton Sea (south), CA, with 12 species and one form; Laysan Island and Waimea, HI, with 11 species; Portal and Ramsey Canyon, AZ, with 10 species; and Point Reyes Peninsula, CA, with nine species. The remainder of the CBCs had eight or fewer high counts. California again led the states for the 28th time in 29 years, with 134 species and nine forms. Texas was second with 105 species and four forms, and was followed by Florida with 84 species and three forms, Hawaii with 71 species and three forms, Arizona with 61 species, Alaska with 30 species and one form, Washington with 27 species, and Massachusetts with 22 species. All other states had high counts of 15 or fewer species.

Only counts for resident species, infraspecific forms, and exotics that do not have editorial comments questioning the validity of the results were accepted for this report. High counts for exotics without known established populations will be displayed, but will not be added to results for the CBC or state. If I make a mistake with this review of the 104th CBC, please let me know, and I will include corrections next year at the end of the column.
